MD, HMR inaugurated a one week Metro technology training course for capacity and skill building for young engineers at Uppal Metro depot today (November 16, 2015). On popular demand from different upcoming Metros in the country and various technical consultancy firms, L&T Metro Rail (Hyderabad) Ltd has launched the technology training program and this is the first batch.

In his inaugural address to the participants belonging to different engineering disciplines in organizations like Nagpur Metro, AECOM, Parsons, L&T, HMR etc., Mr.NVS Reddy highlighted the unique features and advanced technologies of the Hyderabad Metro project. Explaining the dilemmas faced by Hyderabad Metro in choosing between different technology options, he emphasized on the need to absorb the latest technologies and avoid the marketing traps of some of the multinational firms which try to hawk outdated technologies to Indian Metros. Explaining the expanding market for Metro Rail engineers, Mr.Reddy urged the young engineers and managers to master the latest technologies and be aligned to the needs of the people to deliver world class transportation services in Indian cities.
