This facility will enable any commuter to use the 'Uber app' on a mobile phone which will automatically connect with the nearby drivers of uberMOTO which is a motor cycle taxi at the Metro stations. Metro Rail commuters and others can use this wifi enabled facility on their phones to avail a fast, safe and convenient feeder bike ride as a taxi service to their destinations. Mr.Travis Kalanick, Founder & CEO, Uber who came down to Hyderabad for this occasion stated that he is excited to be in Hyderabad for the launch of uberMOTO and to be associated with the progressive and forward looking Government of Telangana. Addressing the gathering, Mr.K.T.Rama Rao highlighted that Telangana is a fast growing "start up state" which encourages innovation and entrepreneurship to make Hyderabad a major global destination. He further mentioned that he is happy to see a win-win collaboration between Hyderabad Metro Rail, which is the world's largest Metro Rail project in PPP mode and a global smart transportation solutions company like Uber.
