The new corporate office at Begumpet is built on 2000 sq.yds of land as a five storied building with a built up area of about 50,000 sft. Built at a cost of around Rs.10 crore by HMRL engineers, the per sq.ft cost of the building with state of the art amenities has set new standards in terms of economy and amenities, stated MD, HMRL Mr. NVS Reddy. Earlier HMRL office was operating from a Government property originally belonging to GHMC and five apartments nearer to the old office.
